Dear Alumni

We began the year with a desire of improving our academics with help of our curriculum coordinator, Mrs. Debbie Queen. We began an organized plan to improve our schools academic scores. We began in August with our staff in-service by planning our teaching and aligning our standards to meet state expectations. The staff planned their teaching by dividing instruction into quarters for the school year. Each staff member gave a pre-test in September, then a mid-term test to evaluate student progress and the mastery of state standards. Now we are in the final stages of the planning by giving the End of Course Exams. We anticipate improvement in our students test scores and an improved score for the school.

Again, our students participate in all the extracurricular activities that other schools do. East students are still involved in the extracurricular activities in both academics and athletics.

Our staff is currently involved in the Ohio Improvement Process. Our District Leadership Team has a plan of improvement prepared for the next three years.
